She will be remembered as an enthusiastic dancer who attended both English and American dances regularly and was always ready to do her share in helping out.

Anne was on the English Country Dance Demonstration Team (the woman with the bright French blue corduroy skirt), was Secretary of the Boston Centre from 1956 to 1960, and for several years edited the monthly "CDS News."




#### BOARD NEWS




